Housing & Shelter

Level 1 - No job.

Food & Nutrition

Level 2 - On food stamps (SNAP).

Level 1 - Homeless or threatened with eviction.

Level 3 - Housing is safe but doesn't meet the family's needs.

Employment & Financial Stability

Level 3 - Full-time; not enough pay; few or no benefits. Level 4 - Full-time with good pay and benefits. (Job)

Level 5 - Housing is safe and meets our needs. Not a housing program.

Level 2 - Temporary, part-time or seasonal; not enough pay; no benefits.

Level 5 - Permanent work with good pay and benefits. (Career)

Level 1 - No food or a way to prepare it. Get food from food pantries.

Level 3 - Have enough food most of the time, sometimes go to a food pantry.

Suicide Facts & Figures: Texas 2018*

On average, one person dies by suicide every three hours in the state.

Twice as many people die by suicide in Texas annually than by homicide.

The total deaths to suicide reflect a total of 76,713 years of potential life lost (YPLL) before age 65.

Suicide cost Texas a total of \$3,516,245,000 of combined lifetime medical and work loss cost in 2010, or an average of \$1,216,273 per suicide death.




