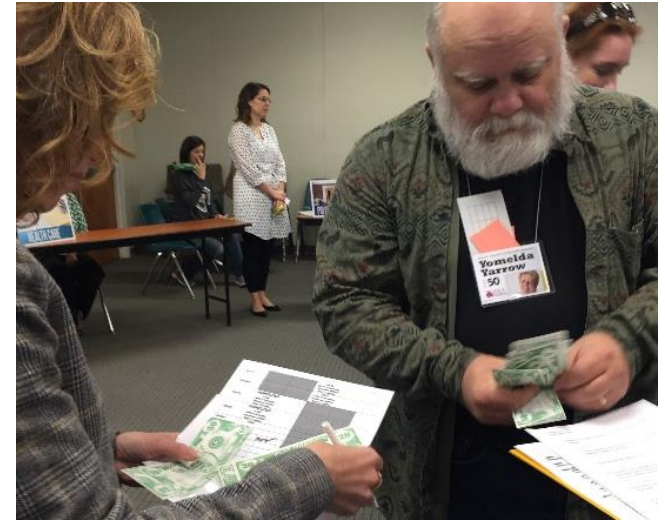

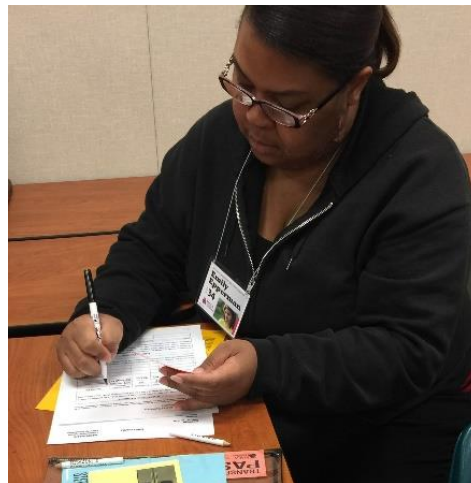

Housing & Shelter

- Level 1 - Homeless or threatened with eviction.
- Level 2 - Pays more than 1/3 of income for rent, or stays in temporary housing program.
- Level 3 - Housing is safe but doesn't meet the family's needs.
- Level 4 - Housing is safe and meets our needs. In a housing program where some or all of the rent is covered.
- Level 5 - Housing is safe and meets our needs. Not a housing program.

Employment & Financial Stability

- Level 1 - No job.
- Level 2 - Temporary, part-time or seasonal; not enough pay; no benefits.
- Level 3 - Full-time; not enough pay; few or no benefits.
- Level 4 - Full-time with good pay and benefits. (Job)
- Level 5 - Permanent work with good pay and benefits. (Career)

Food & Nutrition

- Level 1 - No food or a way to prepare it. Get food from food pantries.
- Level 2 - On food stamps (SNAP).
- Level 3 - Have enough food most of the time, sometimes go to a food pantry.
- Level 4 - Have enough food, don't need help.
- Level 5 - Can buy any food we need.

Childcare

- Level 1 - Need childcare.
- Level 2 - Have childcare, can't count on babysitter or daycare, or can't afford it, or daycare is not good.
- Level 3 - Have childcare, receive program help with the cost.

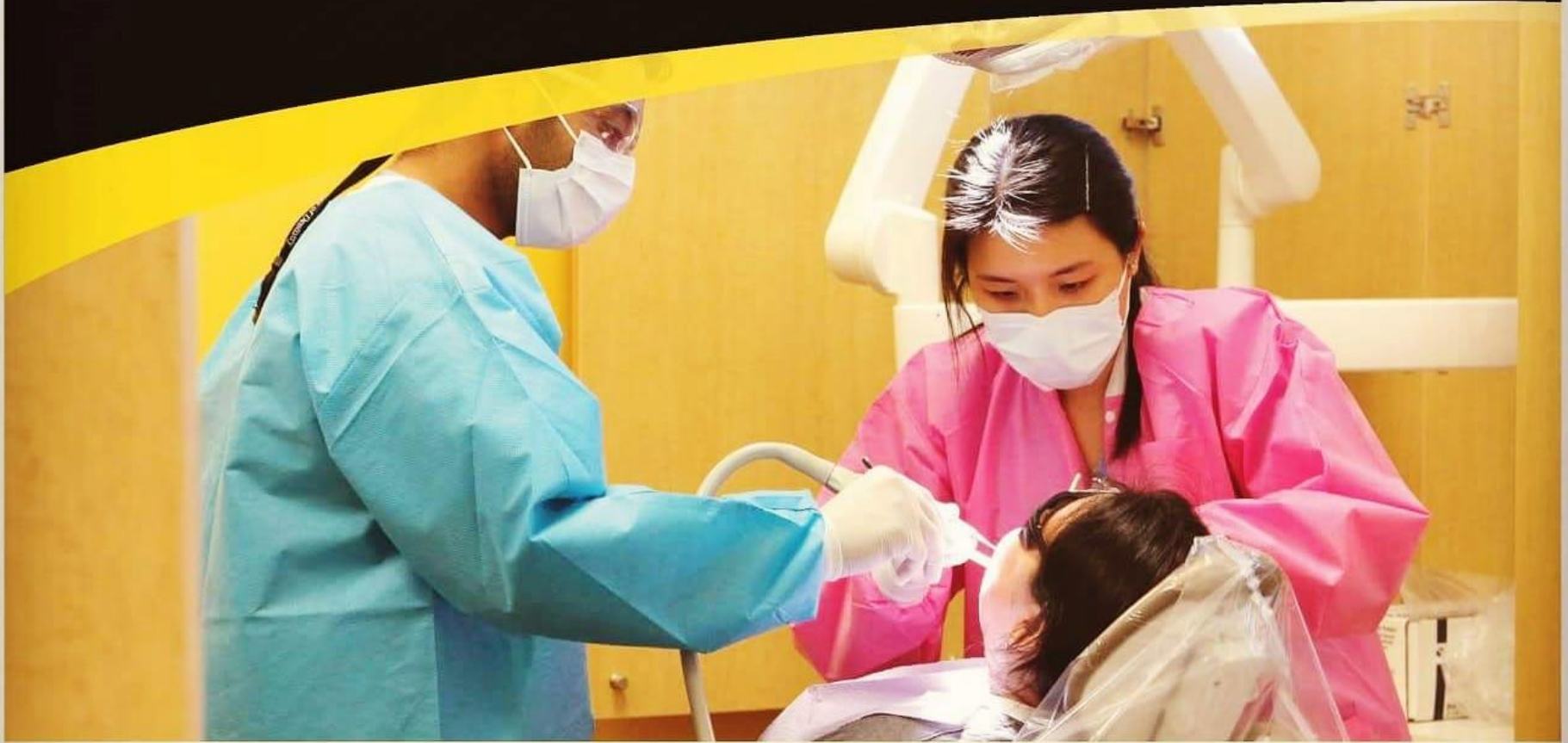

Suicide Facts & Figures:

Texas 2018*



On average, one person dies by suicide every three hours in the state.

Twice as many people die by suicide in Texas annually than by homicide.

The total deaths to suicide reflect a total of 76,713 years of potential life lost (YPLL) before age 65.



Suicide cost Texas a total of **\$3,516,245,000** of combined lifetime medical and work loss cost in 2010, or an average of **\$1,216,273 per suicide death.**

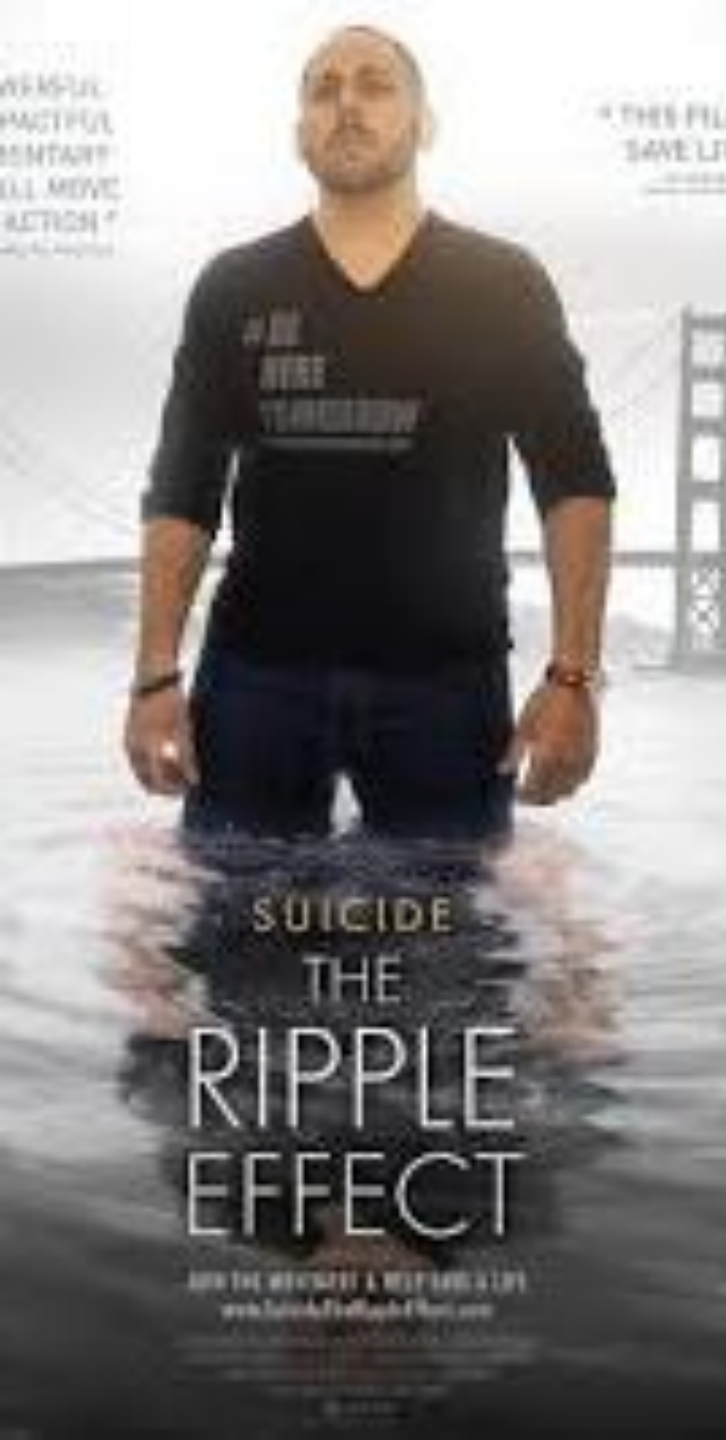

2. Not a perfect exercise.



Privilege Walk



- Begin silently, without speaking, hand in hand in a single line.
- Listen carefully.
- Take the step if it applies to you.
- Don't take a step if it makes you uncomfortable.
- We will return to this room to debrief.

Debrief questions



- Share one word that captures how you are feeling right now.
- How did it feel to be in the front of the line?
- How did it feel to be in the back of the line?
- Were some statements more impactful than others?
- Any new realizations?
