COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNITY NEEDS ASSESSMENT

FEBRUARY

- Councils review and edit existing survey instrument

MARCH

- Finalize survey instrument and request Institutional Review Board Approval

APRIL

- Agency Commitment – **Memorandum of Understanding**

MAY

- Train all partners – ensure everyone passes the IRB Test

JUNE & JULY

- **Conduct the Comprehensive Community Needs Assessment**

AUGUST & SEPTEMBER

- Analyze data and draft report

OCTOBER

- **DATA RELEASE**

NOVEMBER & DECEMBER

- Develop a strategic plan for each council for implementation in January 2020

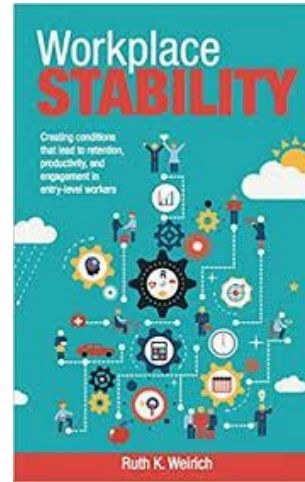
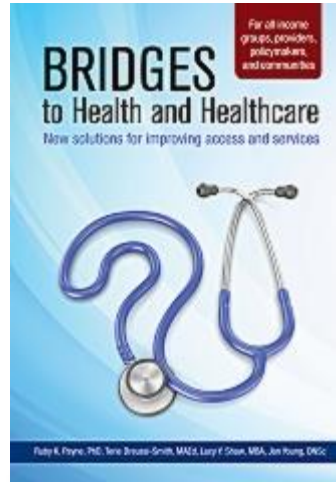
