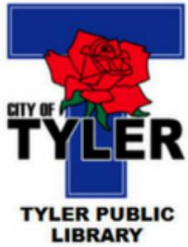
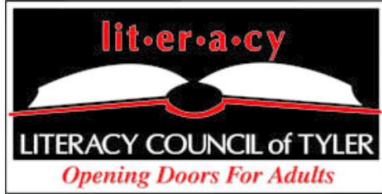

Agency Feedback

Met with an average of 15 individuals. 3 was the smallest number, 30 was the highest.

- 13/18 scheduled follow up appointments
- 2 students were enrolled in CWJC current session
- 1 student is already participating in GED class
- Many signed up for a library card
- 1 person will get new eyeglasses after many years with an old pair
- 1 person will get hearing aids after having lost them

- Organized, good flow, numbers not high but people were the perfect, quality candidates to benefit.
- Very organized. The right people attended. Friendly staff. Great people. Participants were appreciative
- The orientation for agencies. Visiting with other organizations. Ran smoothly

- Shorter time. Want more participants. Follow event with an actual job fair.



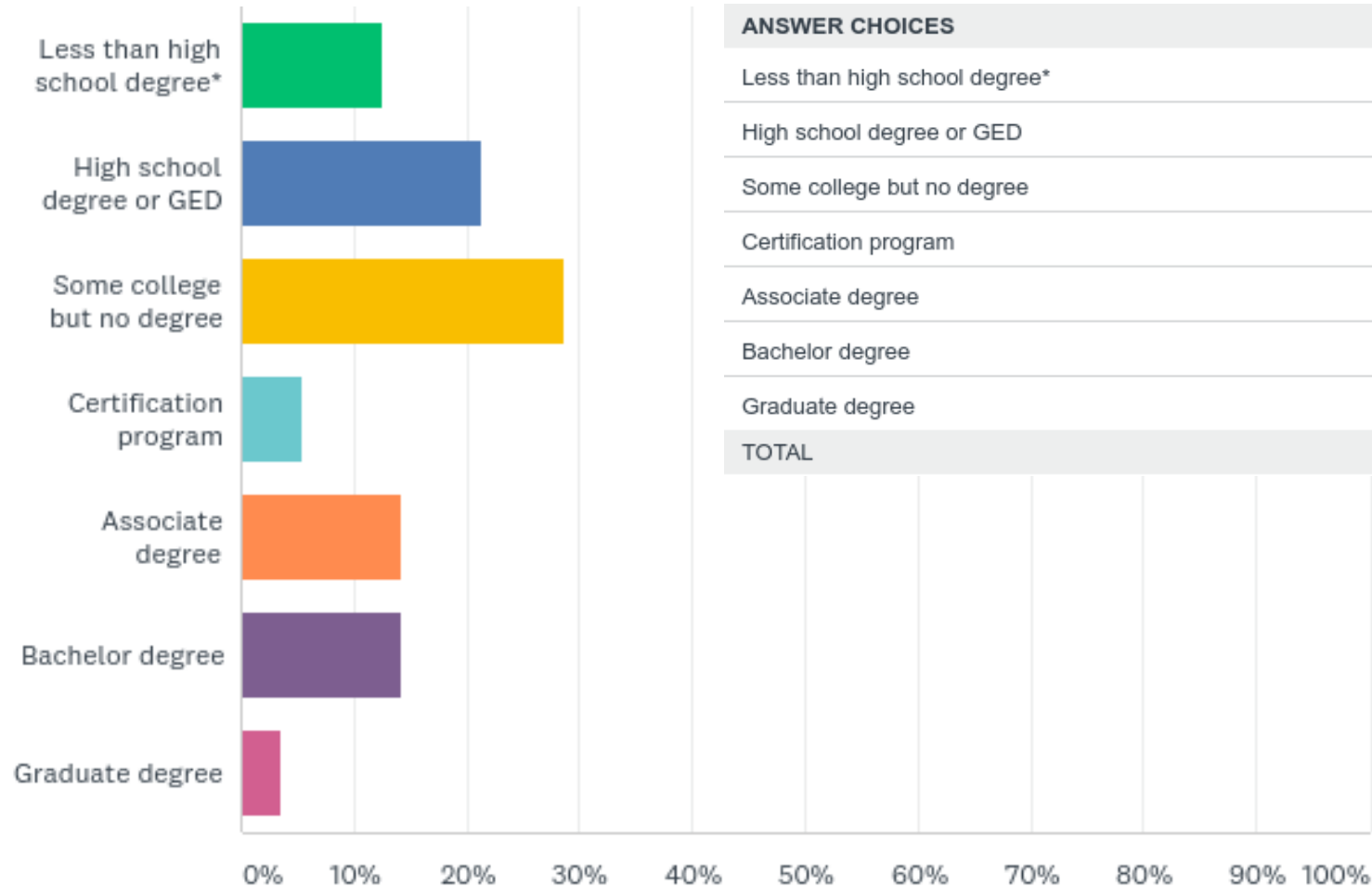
Volunteer Feedback

- Great event, covered all the bases one might need.



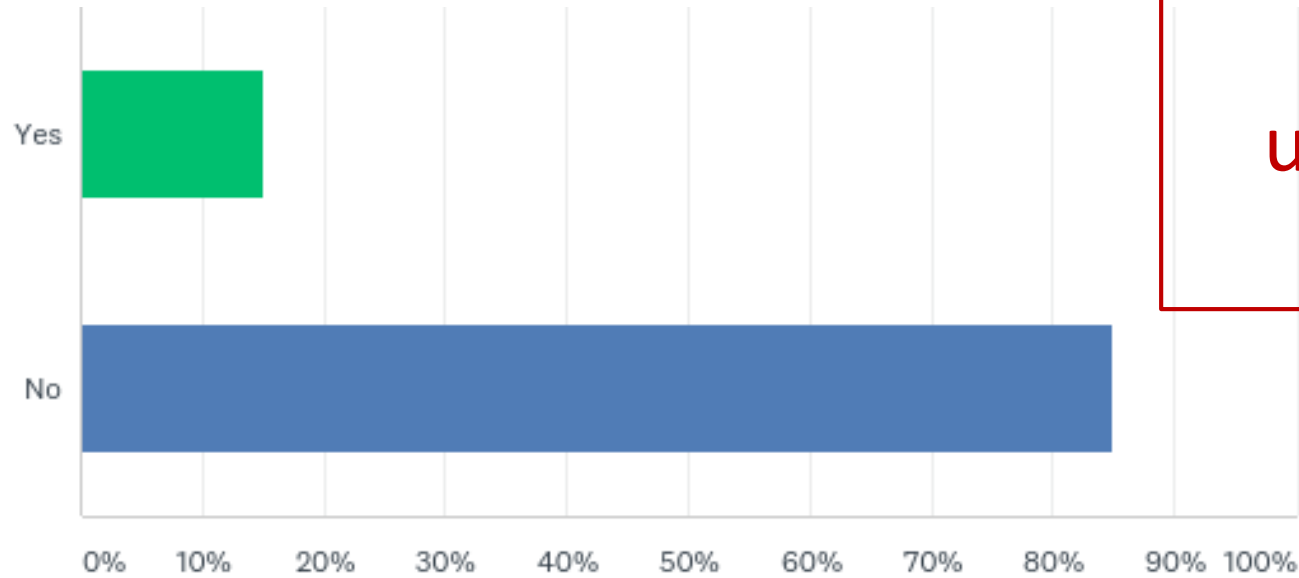
Q17: What is the highest level of school you have completed or the highest degree you have received?

Answered: 40 Skipped: 16

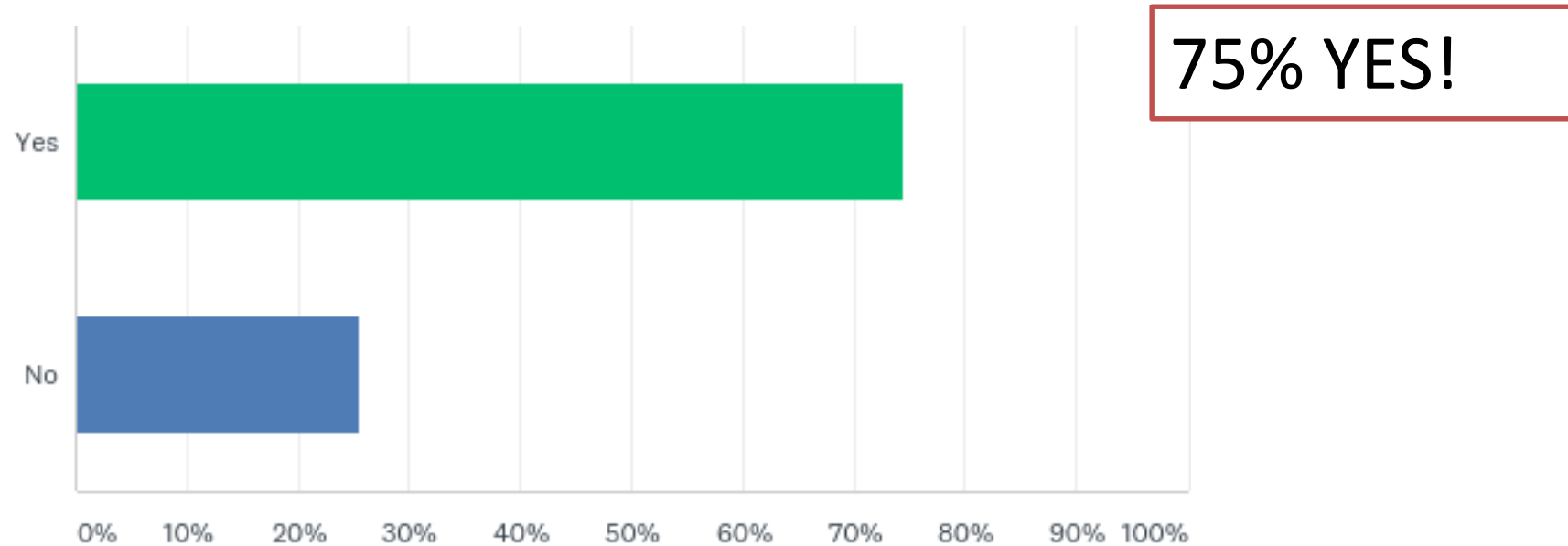


Only 5.56% are receiving unemployment benefits



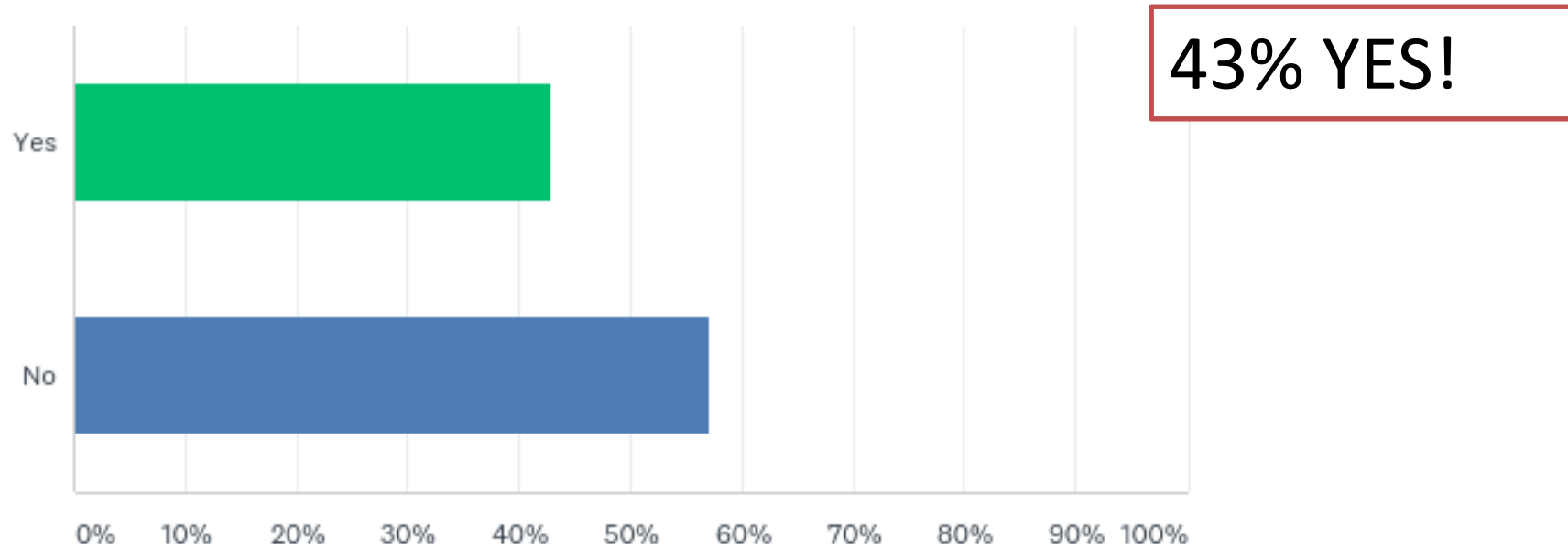
Q23: Want to continue studies? Including certificates

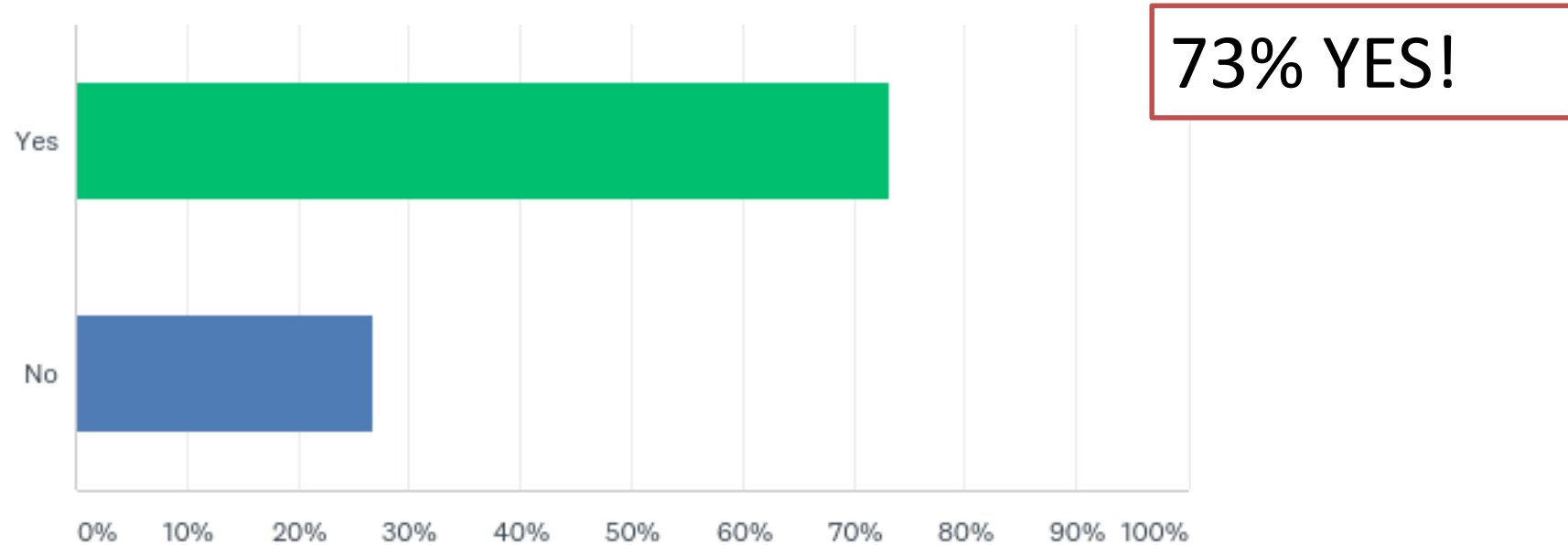
Q25: Would you like to learn how to complete an online application?

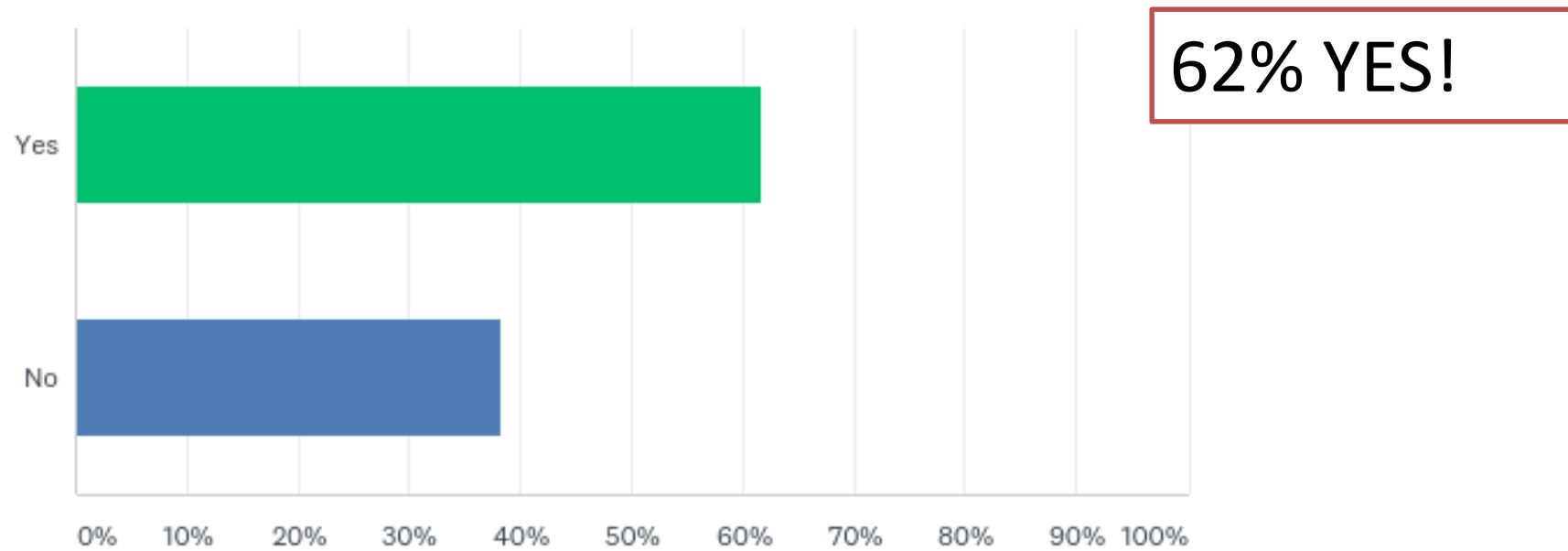
Q26: Would you like to know how to write a resume?

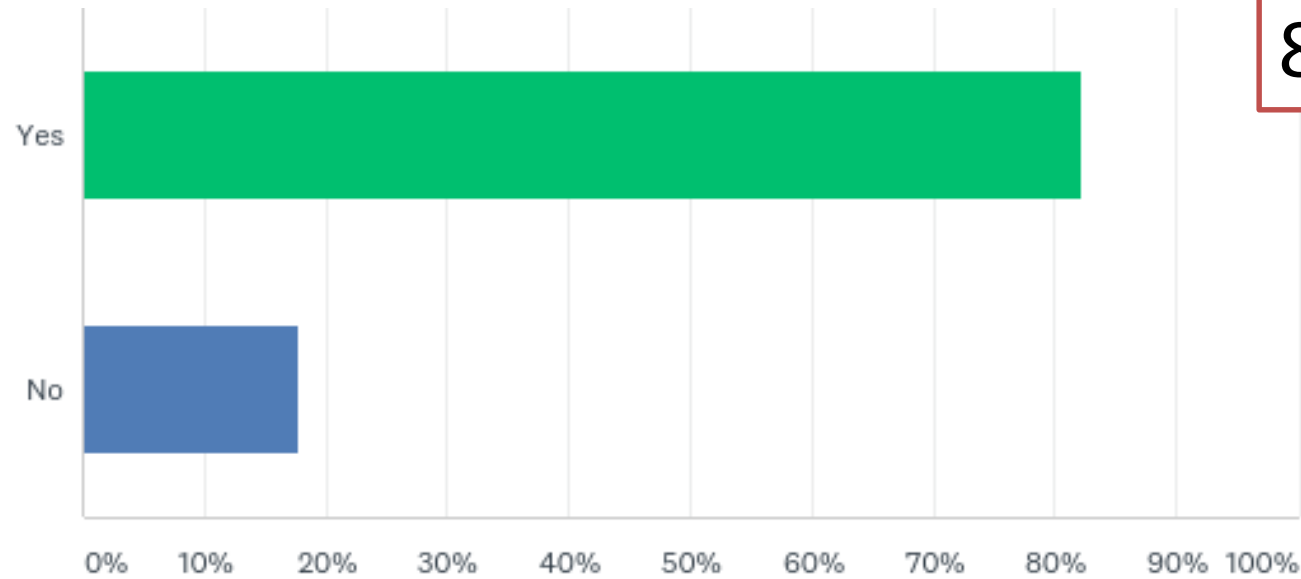
Q28: Would you like to know how to present yourself to an employer? Interview skills

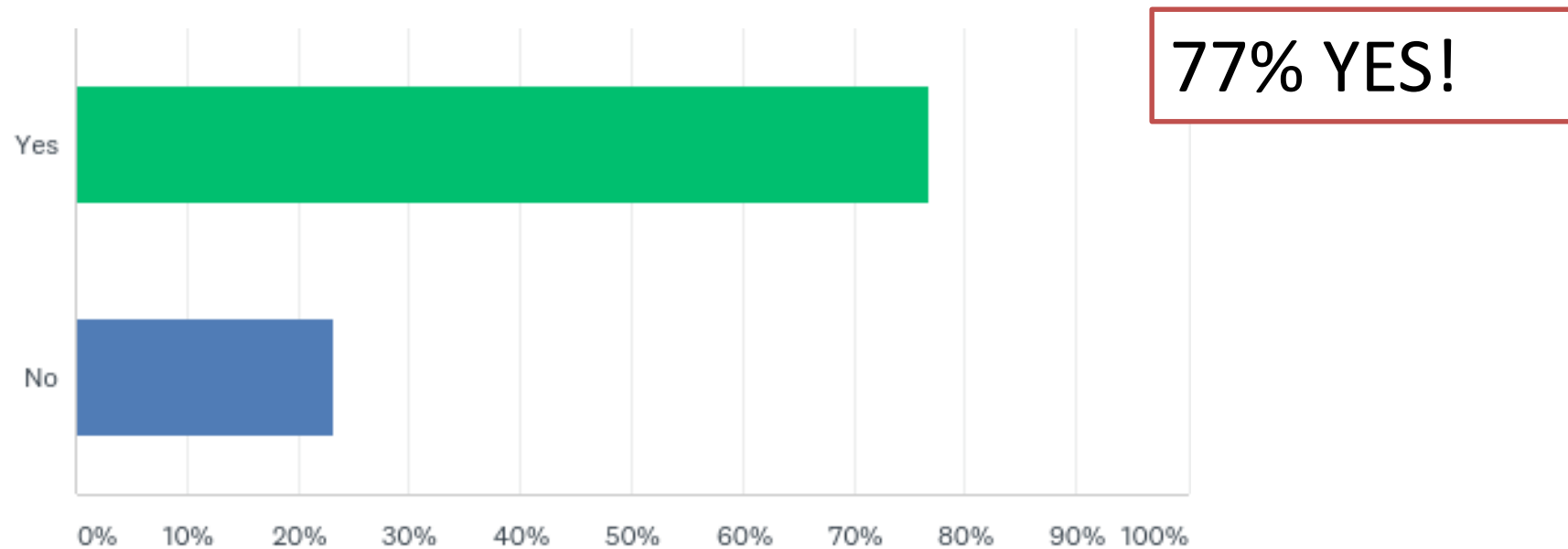

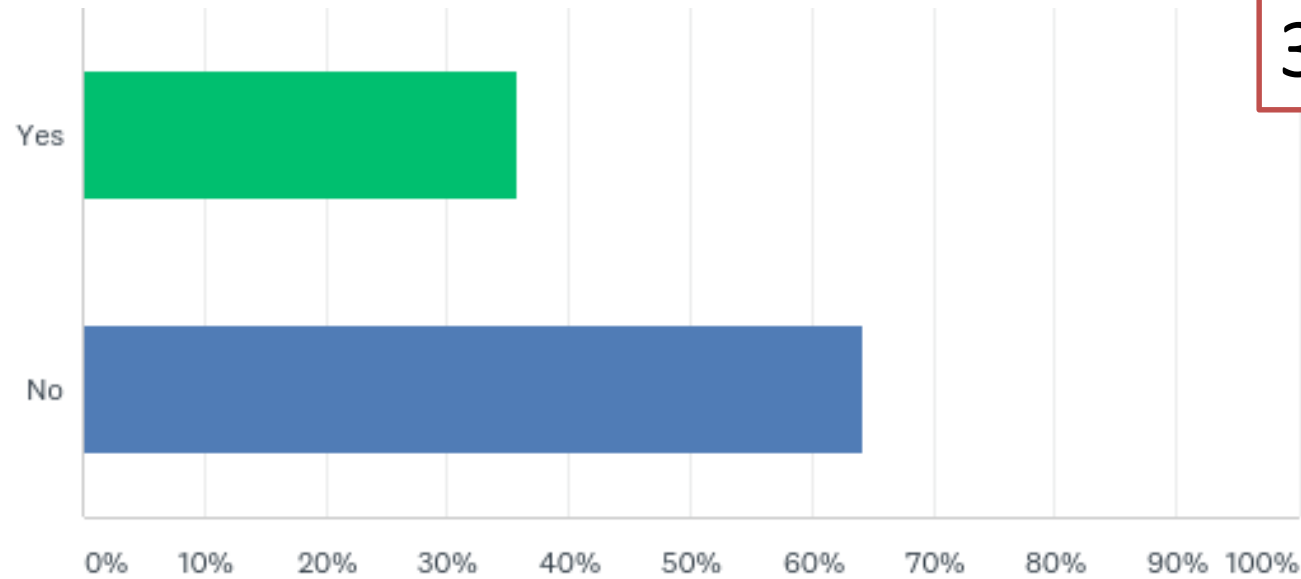
Q31: Would you like to learn how to make short and long term goals?

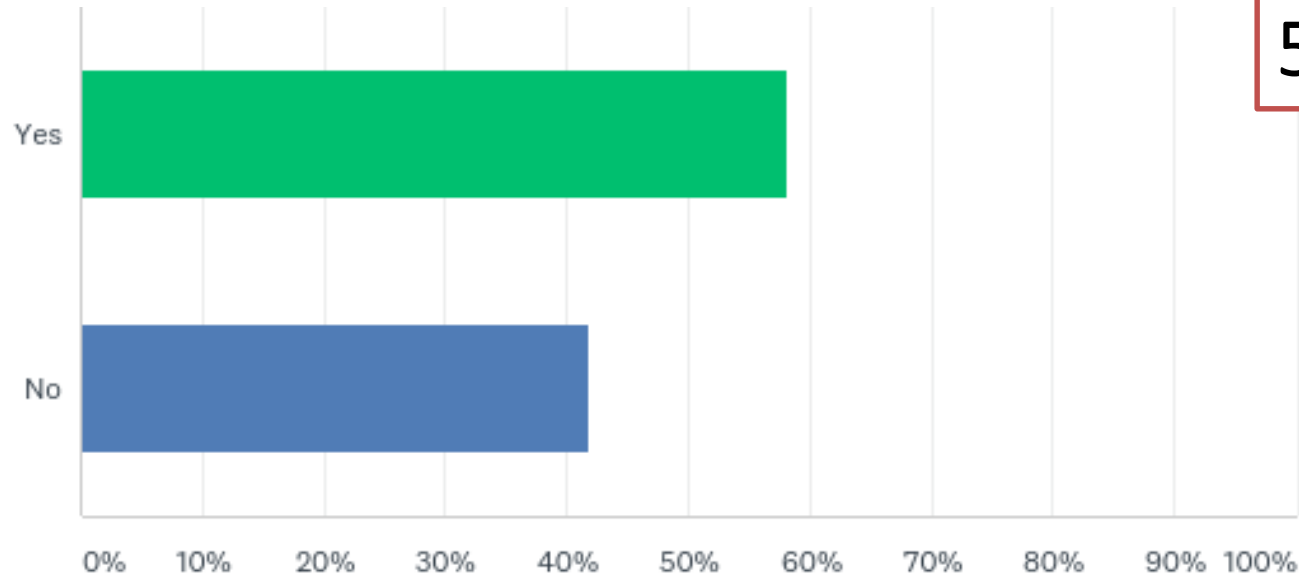

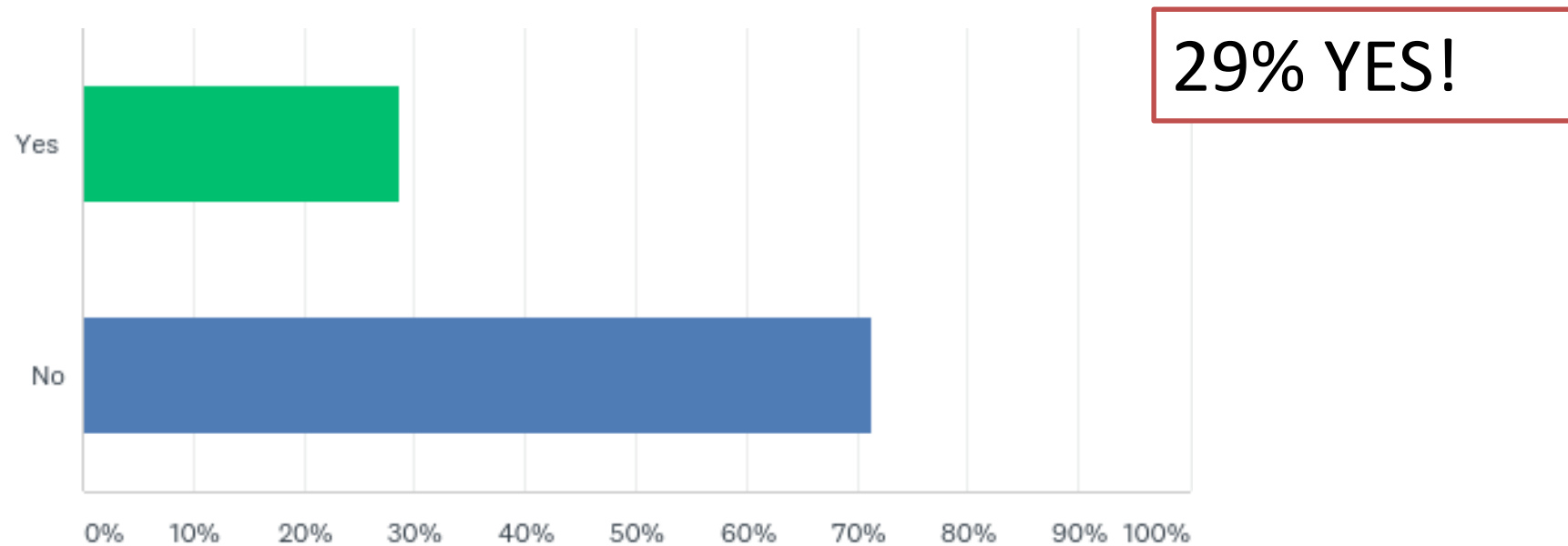

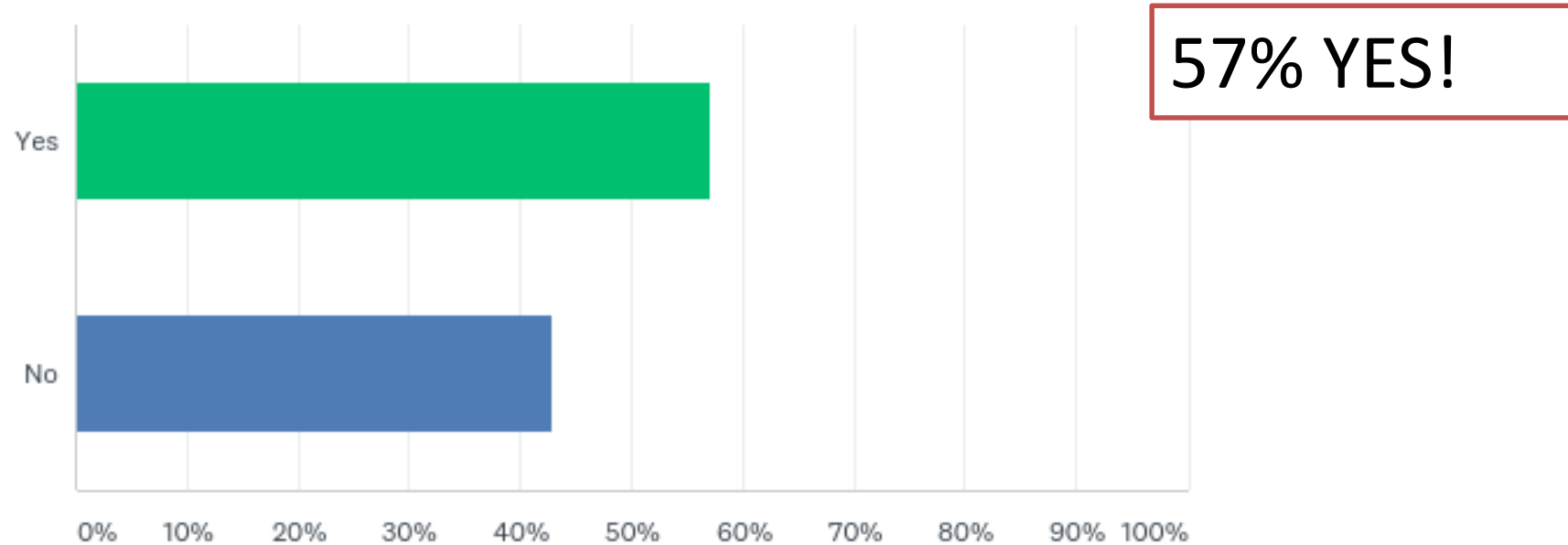
Q35: Have you struggled recently with bothersome thoughts, feelings or behaviors?

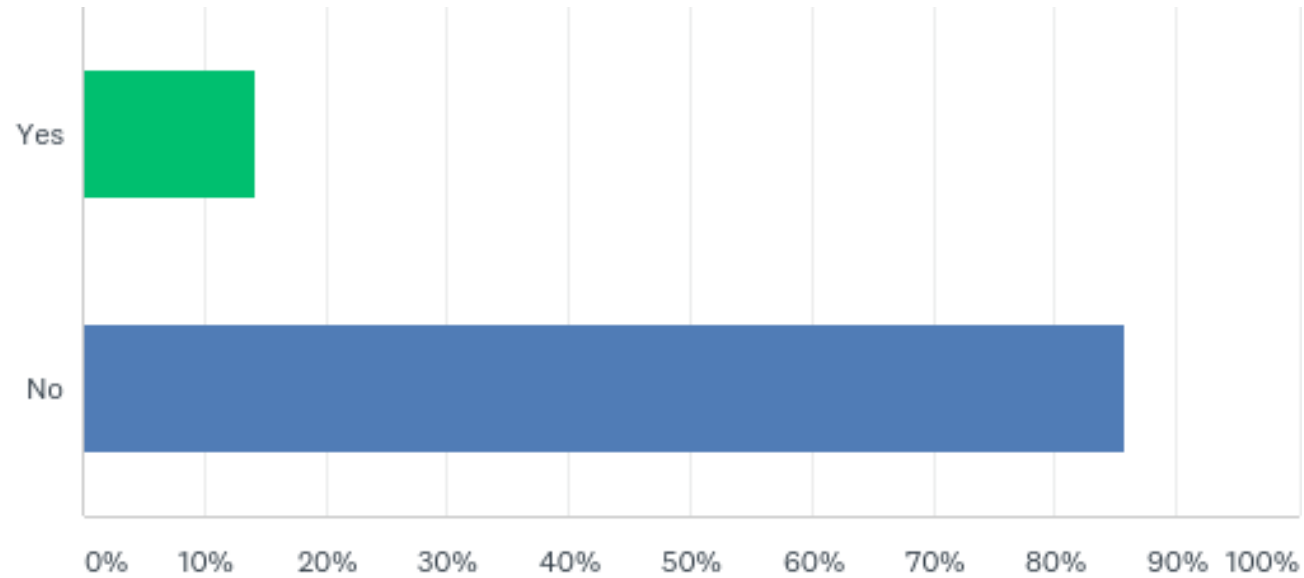

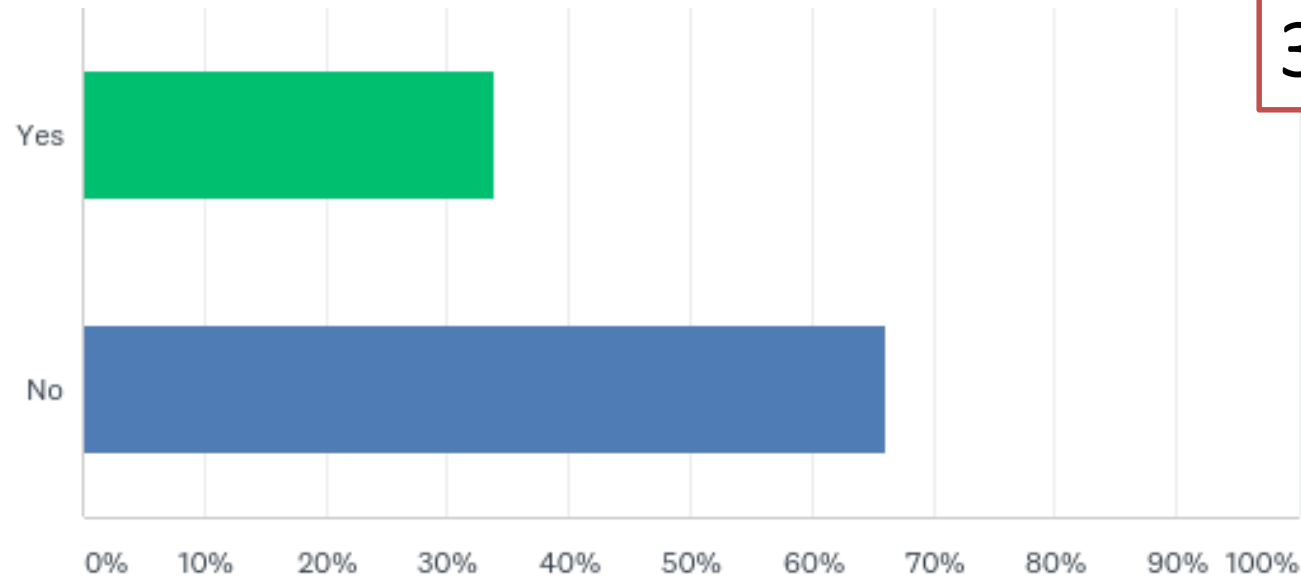
Q45: Do you need childcare assistance?

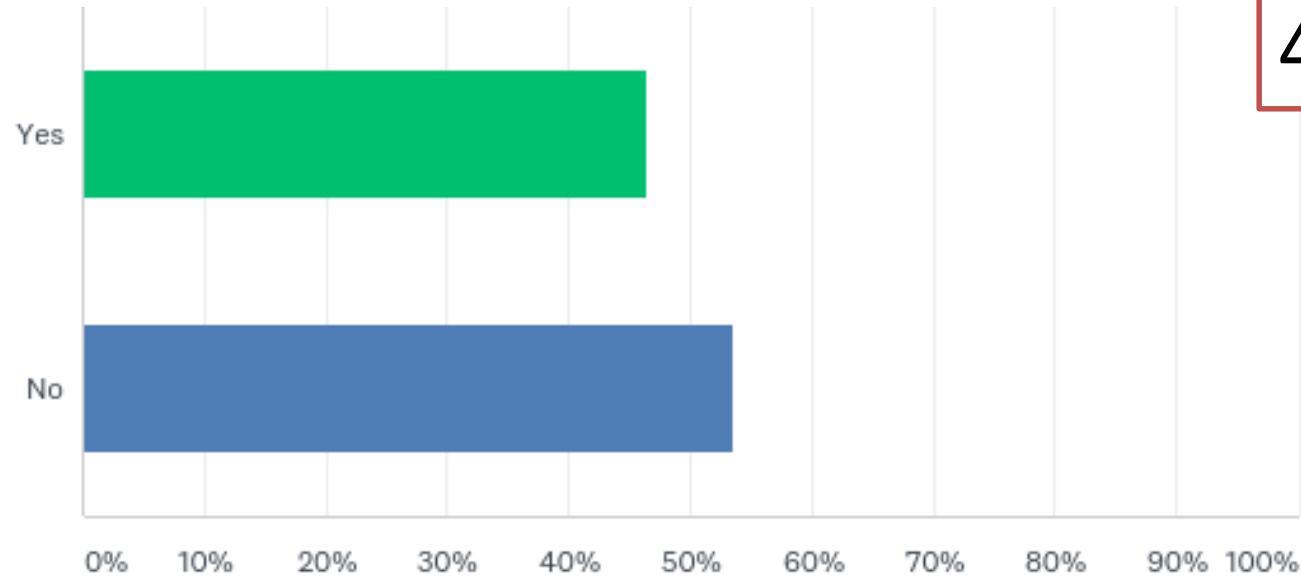

ETHNN COUNCIL CHAIR RESPONSIBILITIES



Leadership:

- Lead committee meetings
- Ensure agendas are created for each meeting
- Serve as the voice and liaison for the committee with ETHNN and the community
- Encourage member involvement in committees.

Member Support:

- Welcome and orient new committee members
- Encourage and support member engagement in the committee

Accountability:

- Identify committee goals and action items
- Ensure action items and accomplishments are captured and reported

COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNITY NEEDS ASSESSMENT



- JANUARY – COUNCILS REVIEW AND EDIT ASSESSMENT
- FEBRUARY – FINALIZE ASSESSMENT
- MARCH – AGENCIES COMMIT TO PARTICIPATION
- APRIL – TRAIN CASEWORKERS (4 HOURS)
- MAY – AGENCIES INFORM CLIENTS
- JUNE – CASEWORKERS CONDUCT INTERVIEWS (30-45 MIN. EACH)

COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNITY NEEDS ASSESSMENT



- JULY – DATA EVALUATION
- AUGUST – FINALIZE REPORT
- SEPTEMBER – COUNCILS ESTABLISH COMMON GOALS
- OCTOBER – COUNCILS DEVELOP WORK-PLAN
- NOVEMBER – COUNCILS WORK TOWARD GOALS
- DECEMBER – COUNCILS WORK TOWARD GOALS
