- 1 person will get hearing aids after having lost them

• Shorter time. Want more participants. Follow event with an actual job fair.




Volunteer Feedback

- Great event, covered all the bases one might need.




Q17: What is the highest level of school you have completed or the highest degree you have received?




Q22: *Want to get a GED? (Only asked if they didn't finish high school)






Q23: Want to continue studies? Including certificates






Q25: Would you like to learn how to complete an online application?






Q26: Would you like to know how to write a resume?






Q28: Would you like to know how to present yourself to an employer? Interview skills






Q29: Would you like to learn more about your strengths, skills, and abilities?






Q31: Would you like to learn how to make short and long term goals?






Q33: Do you need medical care?






Q34: Do you need dental care?






Q35: Have you struggled recently with bothersome thoughts, feelings or behaviors?






Q37: Do you need need health insurance?






Q45: Do you need childcare assistance?






Q46: Do you need food, more or different? Or Food stamps (SNAP)?






Q47: Do you need clothes for work?






Q48: Do you need reliable transportation?






Q49: Are you a US Veteran?

ETHNN COUNCIL CHAIR RESPONSIBILITIES

Leadership:

- Lead committee meetings
- Ensure agendas are created for each meeting

- Welcome and orient new committee members
- Encourage and support member engagement in the committee

Accountability:


