## What is the PIT Count?

The Point-In-Time (PIT) Count is a one-day snapshot of homeless populations in our community that captures the number and characteristics of people who are experiencing homelessness.

## Why?

Knowing the number and nature of people who are homeless and understanding the trends can help our community better understand the scope of the issue, improve system efficiency, strategically plan for resources and promote effective interventions.

- **Homeless Count Surveyor**: These volunteers will canvas our community, hand out comfort kits and conduct surveys with our neighbors experiencing homelessness.
- **Data Entry Operator**: These volunteers will input data collected during the PIT to the Texas Homeless Network website.
- **Sheltered Homeless Surveyor**: These volunteers will work with local housing agencies to survey our neighbors who are housed but still considered homeless.
