[www.903HELP.org](http://www.903HELP.org) was developed by the East Texas Human Needs Network.

“Every moment of every day, individuals we know and love face overwhelming challenges. Imagine a family in crisis: Dad was laid off. The family will be evicted in the next 30 days. Mom is so depressed she can't get out of bed. Twelve year old daughter is struggling with schoolwork and bullying. Seven year old son is in and out of the emergency room for asthma attacks. Would you know where to turn? In this case, even social services providers, counselors, teachers, and nurses need help.” Said Christina Fulsom, ETHNN Founder and Network Weaver.

Anyone with access to the internet, whether on a desktop, tablet, or smartphone is able to use 903HELP. The site also includes a tool that enables users to translate to their native language.
